START MEETING

- What strikes you most in this chapter?
- Best approach to the Olivet Discourse is to do a comparative study of Mt 24 with Mk 13 and Lk 21 and also refer to the apocalyptic literature in books like Daniel and Revelation.

READ AND DISCUSS BIBLE

1. How does Matthew 24 add to Mark 13? Are there any significant differences? Luke was written especially for Gentiles. It is less detailed but arguably clearer than Matthew and Mark in terms of presentation. In what ways is Luke 21 clearer than Matthew 24?
2. What can we learn about the 'Abomination that causes Desolation' from Daniel. (The references are 9:27, 11:31 and 12:11; the three times it is mentioned in his book)
3. How do the first five signs in Mt 24 (as I listed them in my sermon) correspond with the five seals in chapter 6 of the book Revelation?
